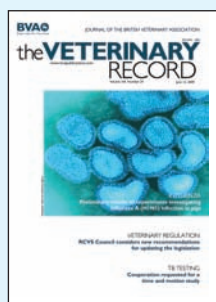
New from the BMJ Group
